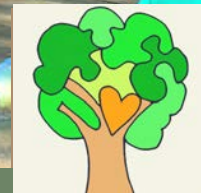

Camp Lakey Gap offers aspiring young professionals an opportunity to gain experience working with autistic clients in a residential summer camp setting. Staff are given the chance for an immersive learning experience while providing for this under-served population.

World-Class Training

We provide all staff with a hands-on professional training that is based on the TEACCH approach. The training team consists of TEACCH-certified trainers, and our Camp Director Jon Blalock is a Certified TEACCH Advanced Consultant who has served autistic clients for almost 20 years. Through a series of lectures, activities, and reverse-shadowing with model campers, staff are well prepared to work with autistic clients of all functioning levels.

Internship Opportunities

We have worked with Universities and Colleges in the past to develop internship opportunities for students in disciplines including Psychology, Recreation Therapy, and Occupational Therapy. Additionally, our setting may be appropriate for disciplines such as Special Education, Speech Therapy, Social Work, and other Human-Service fields. Our program provides 400+ hours of client contact.
